These instructions will allow you to register to Start at [The Pavilion](#). Before you begin, you must have an email account. Set this up first.

To create your own username and password, please follow the simple steps below.



Go to www.startprofile.com and click **Register**



Enter your first name, surname, Email address, postcode and select your gender

Tip: If you forget your username or password we will use this email address to send you a reminder



Choose a memorable username and a secure simple password and click **Get Started**

Tip: Your username needs to be memorable. You may want to use your school network login or you can also use your email address



Click **Login** and enter your username and password. Click **Login**

The first time you log in you will be required to complete the following:

Year 11 Transitions

Starting a new school, college, uni or job can be exciting, but it can also be scary—especially if you don't know anyone.

Some of you may have found it hard getting back to school after the Covid-19 Lockdown.

As part of our response to Covid and our commitment to our stu-

dents,

we decided to support Year 11 students by offering them a 3 day course to prepare them for their next steps. Two award-winning organisations were involved; Voyage Youth and Khulisa.

Both of them worked with small

groups of students to discuss concerns about Covid-19, issues about starting College or 6th Form plus thinking about who they are as young adults moving onto a more independent stage in their lives.

Amazing School Leavers' Success!!

Over 93% of our leavers have a post 16 placement! This is a fantastic result—especially when we're in the middle of a pandemic and job losses are growing.

20 of our 45 leavers have chosen to the two most local

colleges, Barnet and Southgate and Oaklands. 4 students are doing A levels in school 6th forms. 1 student is doing an apprenticeship. The rest are at other London colleges.

This is the best result ever

and shows how seriously Pavilion students take their future.

The work is just beginning to make sure that our new Year 11s have positive post 16 pathways.

If you have any prices of standard products or services, you can include a listing of those here. You may want to refer your readers to

any other forms of communication that you've created for your organization.

You can also use this space to remind readers to mark their calendars for a regular event, such as a breakfast meeting for vendors every third Tuesday of the

month, or a biannual charity auction.
